JOURNAL ENTRY

NOW, on this 9TH day of September 2008, the above-entitled matter comes on before Jack Confer, Acting Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts. After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Acting Executive Director makes the following determinations.

1. On August 11, 2008, the Acting Executive Director, on behalf of the Board, issued a Summary Order which it was determined that Patricia M Ross, RT should be assessed a fine in the amount of \$250.00, payable within 30 days of the effective date of the order, for failure to respond to the Board's request by the June 30, 2008 deadline.

2. The Summary Order contained a notice that a written request for hearing could be filed within 15 days following service, but if no hearing is requested, the Summary Order would become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing.

3. No hearing has been requested by any party and; therefore, the Summary Order became effective on September 2, 2008; and as stated in the Summary Order a civil fine of \$250.00 is payable within 30 days of the effective date.


