**FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING**

**NOW** on this 11<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2005, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Paramjeet Sabharwal, M.D. (“Licensee”) to modify the Final Order issued April 17, 2004, and filed in the Board office on April 22, 2004. Licensee appeared in person *pro se*. Kelli Benintendi, Associate Counsel, appeared for and on behalf of the Board. There were no other appearances.

After hearing the statements of the parties, having the agency record before it and being duly advised in the premises, the Board, finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Licensee was originally issued licensed number 04-30791 to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas on June 19, 2004.
2. Prior to the time the Board granted Licensee’s Application for Licensure, the Board issued a Final Order that limited Licensee’s license, upon its issuance, by prohibiting Licensee from performing or assisting any surgery unless the procedure was performed in a medical care facility that had granted him appropriate clinical privileges and is accredited by a national organization that requires peer review.
3. On April 12, 2005, the Board received Licensee’s request to modify the prior Final Order.

4. From and since the Board entered the Final Order, the Virginia Board of Medicine has reviewed Licensee's conduct at the Northern Virginia Community Hospital that led to the termination of his clinical privileges at that institution and determined that Licensee should be reprimanded for such conduct, but that his Virginia license not be limited in any manner.

5. Licensee has complied with the limitations placed on his license by the Final Order filed April 22, 2004 and good cause exists to terminate the limitations placed upon Licensee's license by the order.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the limitations imposed upon Licensee's license in the Final Order filed April 22, 2004, are hereby terminated.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition under the Kansas Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of agency actions, K.S.A. 77-601 *et seq.* A copy of any such petition must served upon the Board addressed to the Executive Director, 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603. A request for reconsideration is not a prerequisite to judicial review.
