ORDER OF RESCISSION

NOW, on this 21st day of June, 1990, comes for hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts the request of Karl Saffo, M.D. (hereinafter referred to as "Licensee") for rescission of Stipulation dated April 16, 1988.

After reviewing the investigative file and being duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter referred to as "Board") finds as follows:

1. On or about May 2, 1986, information was provided to the Disciplinary Counsel for the Board alleging over-utilization of services by Licensee.

2. Following a thorough investigation into the alleged misconduct, the matter was presented to a Medicine and Surgery Review Committee and two medical consultants were obtained in this matter. The Interim Executive Director of the Board directed Disciplinary Counsel to submit the investigative file to the Board for possible disciplinary proceedings.

3. In lieu of the prosecution of formal charges at a hearing, the parties entered into a Stipulation dated and effective April 16, 1988.

4. The above-mentioned Stipulation contained a clause (paragraph 5) which would allow Licensee, upon the expiration of

two years from the execution date of the Stipulation, to request an appearance before the Board to discuss the modification, amendment, or rescission of the above-mentioned Stipulation.

5. Licensee has requested the rescission of the above-mentioned Stipulation. More than two years have expired since the effective date of the Stipulation.


6. It appears Licensee has fully complied with all of the requirements placed upon him as set forth in the Stipulation from and since the effective date thereof.

7. The Stipulation between the parties should be rescinded in its entirety and hereafter of no force or effect.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE BOARD sitting in regular session that the Stipulation dated April 16, 1988 between the Licensee and the Board be rescinded in its entirety and shall hereafter be null and void and of no further force and effect and Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas shall hereafter be free of the restrictions, requirements, limitations or encumbrances imposed as a result of said Stipulation.
