**FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING**

NOW, on this 23rd day of June, 2001, this matter comes on for conference proceedings before the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") at the request of Gino A. Salerno, (hereafter "Applicant") to grant a second extension to his temporary license pursuant to K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 65-28a07.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information before the Board. Applicant appeared by telephone conference *pro se*.

After hearing statements from the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusion of law and orders:

1. A request for a second extension to temporary license was submitted by Applicant on May 15, 2001 and a Conference Hearing was set for 11:15 a.m. on June 23, 2001.
2. Applicant has applied for permanent licensure as a physician assistant, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 65-28a04.
3. On August 18, 2000, Applicant was granted a temporary registration which expired February 10, 2001.
4. In the Fall of 2000, Applicant took the examination approved by the Board and required

for permanent licensure, but did not receive a passing score.

4. On February 10, 2001, Applicant requested and was granted an extension to his temporary license which expired June 23, 2001.

5. In the spring of 2001, Applicant took the examination approved by the Board and required for permanent licensure, but did not receive a passing score.

6. On June 23, 2001, Applicant requested and was granted a second extension to his temporary license which will expired on December 8, 2001.

7. Pursuant to K.S.A.2000 Supp. 65-28a07, the Board may extend a temporary license upon a majority vote of the members of the Board.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** as follows:

1. Applicant's temporary license as a physician assistant is hereby extended and will expire December 8, 2001. No further extensions will be granted to Applicant's temporary license.

2. This is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days of service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**
