ENFORCEMENT ORDER

NOW, on this 15th day of February, 1989, this matter comes before the Board as a result of a Stipulation having been entered into between the Board and the above-named licensee.

The Kansas State Board of Healing Arts is represented by its Disciplinary Counsel, Joseph M. Furjanic. There are no other appearances.

After examining the file, hearing the statements of counsel and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. That, Licensee shall immediately enroll in and attend the next session of the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey School of Osteopathic Medicine's Mini Residency Program, "The Proper Prescribing of Controlled Dangerous Substances" at 401 Haddon Avenue, Camden, New Jersey.

2. That, Licensee shall not purchase, possess, administer, distribute, or prescribe controlled substances at any time or any place.

3. That, Licensee shall provide to the Board, monthly dispensing reports on the first of each month, commencing on March 1, 1989 and sent to the attention of Joseph M. Furjanic, Disciplinary Counsel for the Board.

4. That, Licensee shall follow all the terms and agreements of this Stipulation for two years beginning on January 24, 1989.


5. That, as long as Licensee remains in strict compliance with the terms and conditions of this Stipulation, no formal adjudicative proceedings will be initiated against Licensee based upon the aforementioned terms and conditions of this Stipulation.

6. That, it is further agreed and understood that the provisions of this Stipulation are to be strictly construed and adhered to.

7. That, this Stipulation shall remain in full force and effect until modified, amended, or rescinded by the parties hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered by the Board that the findings hereinabove made be and the same are hereby made the order of the Board, the Stipulation attached hereto is hereby approved and Licensee is ordered and directed to comply with all provisions thereof.
