

STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 1 day of February, 1989, by and between the **KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS**, (hereinafter referred to as "Board") and **MICHAEL E. SALRIN, D.O.**, (hereinafter referred to as "Licensee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Licensee is currently licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas and holds license number 18532; and

WHEREAS, information was received from the United States Drug Enforcement Administration regarding the possible excessive purchases of the controlled substance known as Didrex by Licensee; and

WHEREAS, after a review of Licensee's prescribing and dispensing practices by Stanley D. Hornbaker, M.D., acting as a medical consultant and agent of the Board, Dr. Hornbaker found Licensee to be inappropriately and questionably prescribing and dispensing controlled substances to his patients; and

WHEREAS, the Disciplinary Counsel and Executive Director of the Board reviewed documents and other material relating to these incidents which revealed matters which could result in the revocation, suspension, or limitation of Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 1987 Supp. 65-2836 through 65-2844 and amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director, Disciplinary Counsel interviewed Licensee for the Board on January 24, 1989 and discussed the above-mentioned matters; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of the prosecution of formal charges at a hearing, the parties mutually desire to enter into a formal Stipulation.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the forbearance of a formal hearing and other covenants and promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. That, Licensee shall immediately enroll in and attend the next session of the University of Medicine & Denistry of New Jersey

School of Osteopathic Medicine's Mini Residency Program, "The Proper Prescribing of Controlled Dangerous Substances" at 401 Haddon Avenue, Camden, New Jersey.

2. That, Licensee shall not purchase, possess, administer, distribute, or prescribe controlled substances at any time or any place.

3. That, Licensee shall provide to the Board, monthly dispensing reports on the first of each month, commencing on March 1, 1989 and sent to the attention of Joseph M. Furjanic, Disciplinary Counsel for the Board.

4. That, Licensee shall follow all the terms and agreements of this Stipulation for two years beginning on January 24, 1989.

5. That, as long as Licensee remains in strict compliance with the terms and conditions of this Stipulation, no formal adjudicative proceedings will be initiated against Licensee based upon the aforementioned terms and conditions of this Stipulation. Any violation of any of the terms by the Licensee shall be prima facie evidence that a violation of the Healing Arts Act has occurred for which the Board may suspend, revoke, or limit the license of the Licensee.


6. That, it is further agreed and understood that the provisions of this Stipulation are to be strictly construed and adhered to. This Stipulation constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and there are no other agreements and understandings not set forth herein. This Stipulation may be modified or amended by written instrument only and signed by the parties hereto.

7. That, this Stipulation shall remain in full force and effect until modified, amended, or rescinded by the parties hereto.




