JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record, the applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On August 22, 2018, the Board issued a Summary Order imposing the requirements therein. The Summary Order became final on September 11, 2018.
2. The Summary Order, upon effectiveness as a Final Order, indefinitely suspended Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas until either Licensee changed his status from Active to Inactive or Exempt, or until such time he obtained and maintains a policy of professional liability insurance as required by K.S.A. 40-3402 and 40-3403a and provides proof of payment of premium surcharges required under K.S.A. 40-3404. The Summary Order also assessed a civil fine of \$500 for violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act.
3. On October 8, 2018, Licensee submitted a check for payment of the assessed \$500 civil


fine.

4. On October 24, 2018, the Board received documents evidencing Licensee had obtained and maintains a policy of professional liability insurance as required under K.S.A. 40-3402 and 40-3403a and provided proof of payment of premium surcharges required under K.S.A. 40-3404.
5. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Summary Order and has no further obligation for compliance.
6. Licensee's license was reinstated to active of December 26, 2018.


