- 4. K.S.A. 77-520 provides that a party against whom a Proposed Default Order is issued may file a written motion within seven days after service of the order requesting that the order be vacated, and if a motion is not so filed, the Proposed Default Order shall become effective.
 - 5. Respondent has not filed a motion requesting that the Proposed Default Order be

vacated and, therefore, by operation of law, the Proposed Default Order became effective September 8, 2004, and Respondent's request for refund of license renewal fee was denied as of that date.

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PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER

NOW ON THIS Fourteenth Day of August 2004, comes before the Board a motion by Dean Samuelson, M.D. for refund of his fee for the 2004-2005 renewal period. Dr. Samuelson does not appear. Stacy L. Cook, Litigation Counsel, appears for the Board.

- 1. The Board finds that Dr. Samuelson is in default by his non-appearance.
- 2. Based upon the agency records of this and prior proceedings, Dr. Samuelson completed the process to renew his license on May 21, 2004. The Board commenced an administrative proceeding June 14, 2004, which resulted in the revocation of Dr. Samuelson's license. At the time he initiated the renewal process, Dr. Samuelson was aware and should have known that the Board anticipated an administrative proceeding, and that revocation of his license was a potential result.
- 3. No statutory authority exists to refund Dr. Samuelson's renewal fee as he requests.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the request for a refund of the renewal fee paid by Dean Samuelson, M.D. is denied.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is proposed default order. A party against whom a proposed default order is issued may seek an order vacating the proposed order by filing a motion for such an order within seven days following service of the proposed order. Any such
