**FINAL ORDER TERMINATING MONITORING REQUIREMENTS**

NOW on this 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 2011, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Timothy T. Sawyer, M.D. (“Licensee”) for termination of practice monitoring. Licensee appears *pro se*. Stacy Bond, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the file, hearing the statements and arguments of Stacy Bond, hearing the testimony of Licensee and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and orders:

1. Licensee is licensed to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, License No. 04-23809, and has been so licensed since approximately October 19, 1991.
2. Licensee’s last known mailing address provided to the Board is: 6650 SW Mission Valley Drive, Topeka, Kansas 66614.
3. On or about August 24, 2010, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board, based upon the fact that Licensee had applied for a change of license designation from exempt to active status. Licensee had not actively practiced medicine and surgery since June 30,

2008. Under the terms of the Consent Order, the Board approved Licensee's request for a change of license designation to active status, but required Licensee to have a practice monitor to ensure Licensee's compliance with community and ethical standards during his re-entry into practice. The monitoring requirements included the submission of monthly reports from the practice monitor.

4. The terms of the Consent Order allow Licensee to request modification or termination of the practice monitoring requirements after a six (6) month period.

5. Since entering into the Consent Order, Licensee has practiced dermatology at the Cotton-O'Neil Clinic in Topeka, Kansas.

6. Licensee's practice has been monitored by Michael Giessel, M.D. for over six (6) months.

7. Dr. Giessel's monthly monitoring reports do not indicate standard of care or practice concerns regarding Licensee.

8. On or about April 19, 2011, Licensee filed a written request to the Board seeking termination of the practice monitoring requirements imposed by the Consent Order.


9. On May 4, 2011, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Licensee's Motion.

10. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS** that Licensee has satisfied all terms and conditions of the Consent Order, and that Licensee's request to terminate the practice monitoring requirements imposed by the Consent Order is hereby granted.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Board shall maintain jurisdiction over this matter to issue any future order(s) deemed necessary and appropriate.


