JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION OF FINAL ORDER

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board under the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801 et seq., as amended, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 et seq., as amended, and upon due consideration of the file and applicable statutes and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. Dawood Sayed, M.D. ("Licensee") has since approximately June 28, 2011 maintained License No. 04-35160 to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

2. Licensee's last known mailing address of record provided to the Board is: confidential Kansas City, Missouri, 64113.

3. On July 15, 2011, following a conference hearing before the Board on June 17, 2011, in accordance with K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-514, and as authorized by K.S.A. 65-2863a, a Final Order was filed by the Board which assessed a civil fine against Licensee in the amount of \$200.00 for violation of the Kansas Healing Arts Act.

4. The Final Order ordered Licensee to remit the assessed civil fine to the Board on or before August 15, 2011. The Final Order directed Licensee to submit payment in the form of a

money order or a check made out to “Kansas State Board of Healing Arts,” to the following: Compliance Coordinator, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, 800 SW Jackson Street, Lower Level- Suite A, Topeka, Kansas 66612.

5. The Final Order notified Licensee that the Final Order was effective upon service, and service of the Final Order was complete upon mailing. The Final Order notified Licensee that, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529, Licensee may petition the Board for Reconsideration of the Final Order within fifteen (15) days following service of the Final Order. Additionally, the Final Order notified Licensee that a party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court, as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.*, and that reconsideration of a Final Order was not a prerequisite to judicial review. The Final Order notified Licensee that a petition for judicial review would not be timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order, and that a copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon Kathleen Selzler Lippert, at 800 SW Jackson, Lower Level-Suite A, Topeka, KS 66612.

6. Pursuant to K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-531, the Final Order was served upon Licensee and Licensee’s attorney or record. A copy of the Final Order was mailed to Licensee at Licensee’s last known address of record with the Board, via United States Mail, first-class postage prepaid.

7. On or about July 29, 2011, Licensee remitted payment in full to the Board of the \$200.00 civil fine.

8. Licensee has satisfied all requirements of the Final Order and has no further obligation for compliance.


9. Licensee has not requested reconsideration of the Final Order or petitioned the

Court for judicial review of the Final Order.


**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Licensee has satisfied all requirements of the Final Order and is discharged from all requirements of the Final Order.
