ORDER OF TERMINATION OF STIPULATION

NOW on this 12th day of December, 1998, comes for conference hearing before the full Board Licensee's request for termination of the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order of March 5, 1998 ("Stipulation") between Baseer A. Sayeed, M.D. ("Licensee") and the Board of Healing Arts ("Board"). Stacy Cook, Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Board. Licensee appears in person.

Having the agency record before it, and after hearing statements from counsel and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. The Stipulation was entered into between Licensee and the Board on March 5, 1998.
2. The Stipulation alleged that Licensee's treatment of patients in an emergency room setting fell below the applicable standard of care to a degree constituting ordinary negligence, and he was therefore limited from providing medical treatment in any emergency room or emergency department until he completed an emergency care course approved by the Board or its designee.

3. Dr. Warren was designated as the Board member to review proposed courses and make the final approval. Dr. Warren approved Licensee's proposal of a California Board Review from October 23-28, 1998.
4. Licensee submitted a Certificate of Completion for attending the California Board Review sponsored by the American College of Emergency Physicians.
5. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 9:45 a.m. on December 12, 1998 was filed herein on November 25, 1998 and served upon Licensee on that same date.
6. Counsel for the Board does not oppose the termination of said Stipulation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDER, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that any and all restrictions and limitations placed on Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas by the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order of March 5, 1998 should be terminated and be of no further force or effect.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
