ORDER ON PETITION TO MODIFY SUSPENSION ORDER

NOW ON THIS 27th day of April, 1996, comes on for hearing Respondent's motion to modify the Board's suspension order, set forth in the Final Order dated February 23, 1996. Respondent appears through Carl E. Cornwell, Attorney at Law. Petitioner appears through Kevin K. LaChance, Disciplinary Counsel.

After hearing the arguments of counsel, and having the agency record before it, the Board modifies the Final Order, dated February 23, 1996 as follows:

1. Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery continues to be revoked as of February 23, 1996.
2. The revocation of Respondent's license is stayed.
3. Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery is hereby limited. Respondent shall be allowed to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas as a charitable health care provider while acting pursuant to the order of the United States District Court, subject to approval by the Board as to practice location.
4. The limitation of licensure and stay of revocation shall be in effect only

until such time as Respondent is released from custody by the federal corrections system. Respondent may seek an extension of the stay upon the same conditions following release from custody for the purpose of continuing his rehabilitation.

5. Notwithstanding the minimum three-year time period for seeking reinstatement as provided in K.S.A. 65-2844, the Board, on its own motion, may consider an application for reinstatement on or after April 27, 1996. Determination of rehabilitation will be made by application of the factors established in *Vakas v. Kansas Bd. of Healing Arts*, 248 Kan. 589 (1991).


