ORDER GRANTING MODIFICATION TO LIMITATION OF LICENSE

NOW ON THIS Twelfth Day of February, 2000, comes before the Board a request by Mark Saylor, M.D., to modify the prior stipulation, agreement and order filed October 17, 1995 in which certain limitations were placed upon his license to practice the healing arts. Dr. Saylor appears in person. Kelli J. Benintendi, Associate Counsel, appears for the Board.


Dr. Saylor requests that the monitoring physicians who have been reporting to the Board on a quarterly basis be required to report only if they observe conditions that give cause for concern.

After hearing the statements of the parties, and having the agency record before it, the Board finds that good cause exists to modify the order as requested.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Stipulation, Agreement and Enforcement Order dated October 17, 1995 is modified. The required quarterly reports from the monitoring physicians must be provided to the Board when the monitoring physician observes any change in conditions that, in their opinion, give cause for concern for the public. All other Board actions relating to this matter are not affected by this order.
