FINAL ORDER

NOW, on this 14th day of August, 2009, the above-entitled matter comes on before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (Board) on Applicant's application for a Student Permit to practice respiratory therapy. Applicant appears in person, *pro se*. Stacy R. Bond, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears for the Board. There are no other appearances.

WHEREUPON, the Board having the agency record before it, being duly advised in the premises and hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, FINDS and ORDERS as follows:

1. On or about February 19, 2009, Applicant submitted an application for a respiratory therapy student permit. Such application was deemed complete and filed on June 22, 2009.
2. Applicant had previously had a student permit cancelled by Summary Order for failure to provide verification of current enrollment in an approved school of respiratory therapy and an anticipated graduation date. (Kansas State Board of Healing Arts Docket Number 09-HA00098)
3. Applicant did not disclose in the application that a previous student permit had been cancelled.
4. In January of 2008, Applicant was the subject of another Summary Order for failure to provide information to the Board.

5. The 2008 Summary Order was not made a Final Order as Applicant provided the requested information to the Board before the Summary Order's effective date.

6. There are grounds for denying Applicant's application pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5510 as elaborated on in K.A.R. 100-55-5 and K.A.R. 100-55-8(c).

7. Applicant's application for a student permit in respiratory therapy is granted.


8. Applicant is fined \$100.

9. Applicant is publically censured.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's Executive Director at 235 SW. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.


