ORDER OF DENIAL OF LICENSE

NOW on this 17th day of November, 1989, comes on for determination by summary proceedings the Application for Endorsement to obtain a license to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas filed by Douglas Lester Schnell. (hereinafter "Applicant").

After considering the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, Richard G. Gannon, Executive Director of the Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board"), serving as a presiding officer in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 77-511 and 77-537, as amended by L. 1989, Ch. 283, finds as follows:

1. That on the 2nd day of November, 1989, Applicant filed with the Board an Application for Endorsement to obtain a license to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas.
2. That after a careful review of Applicant's transcripts which accompanied the Application, the Board can find no indication the Applicant completed course work in Physiotherapy as required for licensure.
3. That Applicant presented to the Board his official transcript and diploma from Pasadena College of Chiropractic.

Said college has not been approved as an accredited chiropractic college by the Board as required by Kansas statutes.

4. That Applicant has provided the Board with his transcript of grades from the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners with an indication of "HAS NOT SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED BOARD EXAMINATIONS". As a result, Applicant has failed to provide evidence of proficiency in the basic sciences as required under Kansas law.

5. That as a result of aforementioned deficiencies as required and pursuant to K.A.R. 100-6-2(b)(3)(A) and (B) and K.A.R. 100-8-2, said Application does not meet statutory prerequisites for licensure nor does it comply with the rules and regulations of the Board.


IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- a. That Applicant's Application for Endorsement received in the Board office November 2, 1989 should be denied.
- b. That Applicant, pursuant to K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 77-511 and 77-537, as amended, is entitled to request a hearing before the Executive Director of the Board or a presiding officer appointed by him on his Application for Endorsement.
- c. That a request by Applicant for a hearing must be made in writing to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, 900 S.W. Jackson, Suite 553, Topeka, Kansas 66612, within fifteen (15) days after service of this Order on Applicant.


d. That this Order will become effective if a hearing is not requested as above stated upon the expiration of the time for requesting such a hearing.


