JOURNAL ENTRY

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon consideration of the file, applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. Mark S. Schryer, L.R.T. (“Licensee”) has, since approximately October 30, 2005, maintained License No. 22-01501 to engage in the practice of Radiological Technology in the State of Kansas.

2. On or about June 16, 2009, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board (“Consent Order”) for alleged violations of the Radiologic Technologists Practice Act, K.S.A. 65-7301, *et seq.* The Consent Order contained the following terms: Licensee’s license to practice radiological technology in the State of Kansas was limited until such time as Licensee received additional training on MRI procedures, was able to demonstrate the he was competent to perform said procedures to the satisfaction of the Board; and, provided the board with documentation evidencing completion of the training and education course.

3. The Board record reflects that, on or about June 16, 2009, Licensee provided the Board with documentation evidencing completion of a training and education course which

satisfied the provision of the Consent Order requiring Licensee's training on MRI procedures, and Licensee demonstrated the he was competent to perform said procedures to the satisfaction of the Board.

4. Licensee has satisfied all requirements of the Consent Order and has no further obligation for compliance.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee has satisfied all terms and conditions of the Consent Order filed on June 16, 2009, and that the allegations set forth in the Consent Order shall be deemed resolved without entry of further order.


