AGREED ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

NOW, on this 13th day of October, 1990, comes on for hearing before the whole board sitting as presiding officer in a summary adjudicative proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 1987 Supp. 77-538, the application of ~~Robert E. Battmer~~, MD, hereinafter referred to as "Licensee", for reinstatement of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Licensee did not appear.

After reviewing the application and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. Licensee was originally granted license 4-21478 practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas on July 1, 1986.
2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 1989 Supp. 65-2809, Licensee's license lapsed on August 1, 1990, due to Licensee's failure to renew said license as specified in said statute. On or about 8/7/90, an order of cancellation was served on licenses which became effective Aug. 27, 1990.
3. On Sept 12, 1990, Licensee filed in the board office an application for reinstatement of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, together with other supporting documentation.
4. Licensee continued to practice medicine and surgery from August 1, 1990 until Sept 12, 1990, although his license to so practice had lapsed pursuant to the statutes of the State of Kansas.
5. It appears the failure of Licensee to properly renew his license prior to its lapse was due solely to inadvertence, negligence and mistake and was not due to any intentional conduct on the part of Licensee.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

A. The findings hereinabove made be and the same are made the order of the Board.

B. The license of Licensee, Martin E. Sellberg, MD, to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas should be reinstated effective August 1, 1990.

C. As a result of Licensee's negligence, inadvertence and mistake in failing to properly renew his license prior to its expiration and continuation to practice from and after August 1, 1990, without proper authority to do so issued by the Board, Licensee should be fined the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200), which sum should be forthwith paid to the Board.

D. Licensee is entitled to an administrative review of this Order of Reinstatement if a written request is received in the board office within 15 days of the date of service of this Order upon Licensee.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
