STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 10 day of January 1985 1985, by and between the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, by and through its Secretary, Richard A. Uhlig, D.O., hereinafter referred to as the Board and Howard A. Serling, D.P.M., 9600 Hadley, Overland Park, Kansas 66212, hereinafter referred to as licensee.

It is understood and agreed that the licensee and the Board have informally discussed the matters concerning the practice of the licensee.

This stipulation is being entered into at the request of the Board and is agreed upon by the licensee, the contents of which are as follows:

- A. That the licensee must not write schedule II prescriptions for himself, his family, or his office use;
- B. **Confidential**
- C. That the licensee must have another physician prescribe schedule II drugs for his own use, and that this prescribing be done by one physician;
- D. That licensee may apply for a D.E.A. Registration only if this stipulation agreement is executed;
- E. That the Board's Investigator, or other designee of the Board shall monitor licensee's practice within the Board's discretion with licensee cooperating with any request made of him in a reasonable fashion to ensure that the licensee is strictly complying with the above conditions.
- F. That the Board and licensee fully understand the conditions herein set forth are intended to be strictly construed and adhered to. That should any of the conditions herein not be fully met, this stipulation agreement will immediately become of no force and effect, and should it be considered necessary by the Board to institute formal proceedings against licensee, said proceedings will be prepared and filed all within the Board's discretion, that the Board in its discretion may revoke, suspend, or limit the license of said licensee.

G. That there have been no other agreements or understandings regarding any other matter in question herein other than what has been expressly set out. Further, this stipulation shall be in full force and effect until and unless either it is rescinded as above set forth by licensee's not adhering to the conditions set forth; or it is modified by written agreement by and between parties.
