KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS

STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 1988, by and between the KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS (hereinafter referred to as "Board") and REUBEN CARROLL SETLIFF, III, M.D. (hereinafter referred to as "Licensee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of October 1987, the Board received an application from Licensee for licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas; and

WHEREAS, on or about January 6, 1988, the Board received certain Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law entered by the Board of Trustees of Memorial Hospital of Sheridan County, Wyoming regarding the staff privileges of Licensee; and

WHEREAS, Licensee has met on an informal basis in a meeting in the board office on February 19, 1988, to discuss the findings and conclusions of the aforementioned board of trustees; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the parties hereto that Licensee receive a temporary permit to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas until the next meeting of the Board to be held April 16, 1988, conditioned upon the limitations set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the issuance to Licensee of a temporary permit, the consideration to be given by the Board a permanent licensure during its meeting in April 1988 and in further consideration of the mutual promises, covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. That Licensee shall have temporary authority to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas from the effective date of this Stipulation through April 16, 1988, subject to the conditions and limitations hereinafter set forth.

2. That Licensee shall not perform either Microantrostomy or Tympanoplasty procedures in the State of Kansas while he remains on the temporary permit to practice in this State from the effective date of this Stipulation until the board meeting on April 16, 1988.

3. That Licensee agrees to appear before the Board at its meeting on April 16, 1988 to discuss the granting of permanent licensure to Licensee.

The exact time for Licensee's appearance before the Board on April 16, 1988 will be provided to Licensee approximately 10 days prior to the meeting.


4. That it is understood and agreed that the provisions of this Stipulation are to be strictly construed and adhered to.

5. That this Stipulation shall remain in full force and effect until April 16, 1988, at which time it shall be null and void and of no further force and effect.


6. That any violation of the terms and conditions of this Stipulation by Licensee may be considered to be a violation of the Healing Arts Act for which the Board may initiate formal adjudicative proceedings under the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act to terminate the temporary permit or to utilize as a basis for denial for permanent licensure to Licensee.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Stipulation on the date indicated below their signature, it being specifically understood that the effective date of this Stipulation will be the date it has been signed by both parties hereto.
