FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT

NOW on this 9th day of August 2013, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the application of Nahid Shahrooz, M.D. (“Applicant”) for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears via teleconference and *pro se*. Reese Hays, Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. On or about November 26, 2012, Applicant submitted an application to the Board for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Such application was complete and filed with the Board on July 9, 2013.
2. Applicant requests that she be granted licensure by endorsement pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2833 based on her medical license in the States of Florida and Indiana.
3. Applicant graduated from medical school in 1974, from Mashad University of Medical Sciences in Mashad, Iran.


4. Applicant currently holds active medical licenses in Florida and Indiana which have not been subject to discipline.

5. Applicant has engaged in the active practice of medicine in Indiana since October of 2006.

6. The Board finds that the Applicant has demonstrated satisfactory fulfillment of the active practice requirement of K.S.A. 65-2833 to be granted a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Applicant is hereby GRANTED a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

Additionally, a party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court, as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within **30 days** following service of the Final Order. 
