## ENFORCEMENT ORDER

NOW, on this 15 th day of June, 1990, this matter comes on for consideration by the Kansas state Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") pursuant to K.S.A. 1989 Supp. $65-2838$ based upon a Stipulation having been entered into between the Board and Richard N. Shatz, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant"). The Board appears by and through its General Counsel, Lawrence T. Buening, Jr. There are no other appearances.

After examining the files, hearing the statements of counsel and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

1. On or about May 2, 1990, Applicant filed with the Board an application for endorsement to obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.
2. Applicant has admittedly committed certain acts which may be in violation of the Kansas Healing Arts Act as set forth in K.S.A. 1989 Supp. 65-2836 for which Applicant's application may be denied pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2805.
3. In lieu of formal proceedings under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, the Board and Applicant have heretofore entered into a Stipulation dated June 15, 1990, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", in which the parties have agreed that upon approval of Applicant's application for endorsement. Applicant's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas shall be limited pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:
A. The findings hereinabove made be and the same are hereby made the Order of the Board.
B. Applicant's application for endorsement is hereby approved and Licensee is hereby issued license number 4-23201 to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.
C. The Stipulation attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and all findings of fact stated therein are hereby adopted by the Board and the Stipulation is hereby approved and made binding upon the Board and Applicant's license hereby issued is limited in accordance therewith.
D. Any violation of the Stipulation shall constitute a violation of the Healing Arts Act and administrative proceedings may be initiated against Applicant for the revocation, suspension or limitation of said Applicant's license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.

## STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this day of June, 1990, by and between RICHARD N. SHATZ, M.D. (hereinafter referred to as "Applicant") and the KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS (hereinafter referred to as "Board").

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on or about February 26, 1990, Applicant filed with the Board an application for erdorsement to obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery ir the State of Kansas; and

WHEREAS, Applicant was requested to provide additional information, which information ras now been received by the Board and the application deemed to be complete; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received information indicating prior actions have been taken by the Nissouri Board of Registration for the Healing Arts, the Missouri Jepartment of Health and the Drug Enforcement Administration of tre U.S. Department of Justice; and WHEREAS, the actions take: by the Missouri Department of Health and the Drug Enforcement Administration enable Applicant to utilize controlled substances in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Missouri subject to his continued compliance with certain restrictions, requirements and obligations which have been imposed; and

WHEREAS, the investigation conducted by the Board reveals the aforementioned actions have been based upon Applicant's plea of guilty on November 23, 1983 to one count of knowingly and willfully
acquiring and possessing cocaine by misrepresentation, fraud, forgery, deception or subterfuge; and

WHEREAS, the Missouri Board of Registration for the Healing Arts has previously reinstated Applicant's license and on December 3, 1988 voted to terminate Applicant's Probationary Agreement and removed all restrictions placed on his license to practice medicine and surgery in that state; and

WHEREAS, the Board has beer led to believe Applicant has not ingested any controlled substance without a lawful medical reason therefor since 1982.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the granting to Applicant of a temporary permit to practice: medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas and the other mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the parties hereto agreє as follows:

1. The Board, immediately upon receipt of Applicant's signed copy of this Stipulation, will issue to Applicant a temporary permit to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.
2. Upon receipt of a temporary and, subsequently, a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, Applicant agrees as follows:
a. To refrain from the ingestion, inhalation, injection or other use of any controlled substances unless prescribed or administered by a licensed practitioner.
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c. To comply with and akide by all of the restrictions, requirements and obligations placed upon him by Memorandum of Understanding dated September 30, 1986 between Applicant and the Missouri Department of Health and the Memorandum of Agreement dated September :., 1989 between Applicant and the Drug Enforcement Administration for as long as any such restrictions, requirements and obligations so imposed remain in effect.
d. To notify the Board of any modification to his license status in the state of Missouri and any modification to the restrictions, requirements and obligations placed upon him by either the aforementioned Nemorandum of Understanding or the Memorandum of Agreement.
3. This Stipulation shall se binding upon both the Board and Applicant upon its approval by both parties and the issuance of an Enforcement Order in accordance therewith. In the event Applicant, prior to the issuance by the Board of a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, shall violate any of the terms and conditions of this Stipulation, the Board may refuse to grant a permanent license to Applicant and further may take such action as it deems necessary to suspend, revoke or otherwise limit any temporary permit which may have been granted to Applicant.
4. This Stipulation and the promises and obligations contained herein shall remain ir effect for as long as Applicant shall have a temporary permit or permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas, provided, however, should Applicant adhere to all of the restrictions, requirements and obligations imposed upon him by the aforementioned Memorandum of Understanding and Memorandum of Agreement, the terms and conditions of the monitoring contract with Kansas Medical Society Impaired Provider Program and the terms and conditions of this Stipulation, Applicant may request the rescission of this Stipulation and such request will be given due consideration by the Board.
5. Applicant understands that the failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions her inabove set forth will constitute a violation of the Kansas Hea:.ing Arts Act and may result in proceedings to revoke, suspend or limit the temporary permit issued to applicant or any permanent license which may be issued to Applicant.
6. This Stipulation contains the entire agreement between the parties hereto and the terms hereof are understood to be strictly construed and to be adhered to.
7. Applicant has entered into this Stipulation freely and voluntarily as a consideration for the issuance of a temporary permit and acknowledges that there has been no coercion or duress imposed upon him to enter into this Stipulation. Applicant hereby waives any and all rights to due process and hearing on his

Application for Endorsement conferred upon him by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act or any other Federal or State law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the par ies hereto have entered into this agreement the date and year incicated below their signature, it being specifically understood this agreement shall not become effective and binding upon both jarties until it has been executed and approved by both parties hereto.
