**JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION REINSTATING LICENSE TO INACTIVE**

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record, the applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On March 21, 2019, the Board issued a Summary Order imposing the requirements therein.
2. The Summary Order, upon effectiveness as a Final Order, would indefinitely suspend Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas until either Licensee changed her status from Active to Inactive or Exempt, or until such time she obtained and maintained a policy of professional liability insurance as required by K.S.A. 40-3402 and 40-3403a and provides proof of payment of premium surcharges required under K.S.A. 40-3404. The Summary Order also assessed a civil fine of \$500 for violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act.
3. On March 26, 2019, prior to the Summary Order’s effectiveness as a Final Order, Licensee changed her license status to inactive.
4. Therefore, Licensee was not suspended at any time.

5. Should Licensee change her licensee status to active, Licensee must provide proof she has obtained and maintains a policy of professional liability insurance as required by K.S.A. 40-3402 and 40- 3403a, and provide proof of payment of premium surcharges required under K.S.A. 40-3404.
6. On April 1, 2019, Licensee submitted a check for payment of the assessed \$500 civil fine.
7. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Summary Order and has no further obligation for compliance.


