AMENDED ORDER DENYING SECOND TEMPORARY REGISTRATION

NOW on this 14th day of October, 1995, this matter comes on for conference proceedings before the full Board pursuant to K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535, at the request of Kalwant Singh (hereinafter "Applicant") to grant a second temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408(d).

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board"). There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the file, hearing statements of the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. A request for second temporary registration was received from Kalwant Singh on August 21, 1995.
2. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 8:45 a.m. on October 14, 1995 was filed herein on September 29, 1995 and served on Applicant on that same date.
3. Applicant has applied for permanent registration as an occupational therapist, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-5406(a)(3).

4. Applicant was granted temporary registration number 9403574, which expires September 1, 1995.

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408(d), not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6. The Board finds that insufficient cause exists to grant Applicant a second temporary registration. Applicant may reapply for a second temporary registration once he has passed the required exam, has provided proof as such, and has met all of the requirements for permanent certification as an occupational therapist.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

- a. That Applicant's request for a second temporary registration is denied.
- b. That this is a final order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days of service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.


