FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT

NOW on this 23rd day of June, 1995, this matter comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board") sitting as a whole in a conference proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535, the application of Tamea R. Sisco, D.C. ("Applicant") for licensure by endorsement. Shelly Gasper, Acting Associate Counsel, appears for and on behalf of the Board. Applicant appears in person.

After reviewing the application, hearing statements from Applicant and counsel for the Board, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On July 30, 1993, Applicant submitted her application for licensure by endorsement to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas. Said application was deemed complete on April 29, 1994.

2. Applicant was granted a temporary permit to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas effective June 3, 1994 and expiring August 3, 1995.

FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT

3. Upon review and investigation of Applicant's practice of chiropractic in the State of Colorado, the Board grants Applicant's application for licensure.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED as follows:

A. That the findings here and above made be and the same are made Order of the Board.


B. Applicant's application should be placed on the board agenda for final approval and issuance of a permanent license at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board; in the interim, Applicant, having paid the appropriate fee, is entitled to an extension of her temporary permit under K.S.A. 65-2811(a)(1), until the permanent license is issued.

C. This is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration, stating the specific grounds upon which relief is requested. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.



SUMMARY ORDER

NOW, on this 29th day of April, 1995, this matter comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole as a presiding office in a summary proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-537 through 77-541, the Application for License by Endorsement filed by Tamea R. Sisco-Skinner, D.C. (hereafter "Applicant") to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information before the Board. Applicant did not appear.

After reviewing the application and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On July 3, 1993, Applicant submitted an Application for License by Endorsement to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas and which application was deemed complete on April 29, 1994.

2. At the Board Meeting held June 3, 1994, following conference proceedings, the Board issued a Final Order which granted to Applicant a temporary permit to practice chiropractic effective June 3, 1994 and expiring June 3, 1995 and further tabled

action on Applicant's application for permanent licensure during such period of time.

3. The next meeting of the Board will be held June 23 and 24, 1995.

4. Applicant's temporary permit should be extended an additional sixty (60) days to expire August 3, 1995 to enable the Board to further consider Applicant's application for permanent license at its meeting to be conducted June 23, 1995 and Applicant should be provided with a Notice of Conference Hearing specifying the date and time that the Board will consider Applicant's application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

a) The findings here and above made be and the same are made the order of the Board.

b) Applicant's temporary permit 9400127 should be extended an additional sixty (60) days to August 3, 1995 to enable the Board to further consider Applicant's application for permanent licensure at its meeting to be conducted June 23 and 24, 1995.

c) That a Notice of Conference Hearing be provided to Applicant specifying the date and time the Board will further consider Applicant's Application for License by Endorsement to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas.

d) Either party is entitled to an administrative review of this order if a written request is received in the Board office within ten (10) days of service of this order upon the parties.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
