SUMMARY ORDER

NOW ON THIS 3rd day of ~~November~~ December, 2008, this matter comes before John (Jack)

Confer, Acting Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537. This Summary Order shall become effective as a Final Order, without further notice, upon the expiration of the fifteen (15) day period if no request for hearing is made, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-542.

Upon review of the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order are made for and on behalf of the Board:

Findings of Fact

1. Sabato Sisillo, M.D. ("Licensee") was originally issued license number 04-25382 to practice as a medical doctor in the state of Kansas on October 15, 1994. Licensee's license is active, having last been renewed on or about July 1, 2008.
2. Licensee's last known mailing address as provided to the Board at the time of his renewal is 8614 Lamar Ave., Overland Park, KS 66207.
3. On November 14, 2002, Licensee was convicted in Johnson County District Court of one count of Violation of a Protection Order, a class A misdemeanor in case number 02DV1329.

4. On November 19, 2003, Licensee was convicted in Johnson County District Court of one count of Telephone Harassment, a class A misdemeanor in case number 03DV01103.

5. Licensee did not disclose either his arrest or conviction in these cases on either of his 2003 or 2004 renewal application.

6. On July 29, 2008, Board staff received a one page fax from Licensee's attorney stating that the Licensee admits he did not answer yes to the arrest question on his license renewals in 2003 and has no excuse for not doing so.

7. All pending investigation materials regarding Licensee were fully reviewed and considered by the Board members who serve on the Board's Disciplinary Panel. The Disciplinary Panel authorized and directed the issuance of this Summary Order and the specific disciplinary sanctions pursuant to Board Guidelines.

Applicable Law

8. K.S.A. 65-2836 states, in pertinent part: A licensee's license may be revoked, suspended, or limited or the licensee may be publicly or privately censured, or an application for license or for reinstatement of a license may be denied upon finding of the existence of any of the following grounds:

- (a) The licensee has committed fraud or misrepresentation in applying for or securing an original, renewal or reinstated license.
- (c) The licensee has been convicted of a felony or a class A misdemeanor, whether or not related to the practice of the healing arts.

Conclusions of Law

9. The Board has jurisdiction over Licensee as well as the subject matter of this proceeding, and such proceeding is held in the public interest.

10. Licensee's conviction of Violation of a Protective Order, a class A misdemeanor

and Telephone Harassment, a class A misdemeanor, constitutes a violation of K.S.A. 65-2836(c).

11. Licensee's failure to disclose these convictions on his 2003 and 2004 application renewal is a violation of K.S.A. 65-2836(a).

12. Based on the facts and circumstances set forth herein, it appears that the use of summary proceedings in this matter is appropriate, in accordance with the provisions set forth in K.S.A. 77-537(a), in that the use of summary proceedings does not violate any provision of the law and the protection of the public interest does not require the Board to give notice and opportunity to participate to persons other than Licensee, Sabato Sisillo, M.D.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Licensee is hereby **FINED \$500** for violating the Healing Arts Act. Said fine is due and payable to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts within 30 days of the effective date of this order.

NOTICE AND OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Summary Order. A party to whom a Summary Order is issued may file a written request for a hearing pursuant to K.S.A. 77-542 within 15 days following service of the Summary Order. Such written request shall also state the legal and/or factual basis upon which the party opposes this Order. If a hearing is not requested, the Summary Order shall become effective as a Final Order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing. A written request for hearing must be addressed and mailed to Jack Confer, Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.




Wherefore, the Board finds as follows:
