ORDER GRANTING THIRD TEMPORARY REGISTRATION

NOW, on this 11th day of February, 1995, this matter comes on for conference proceedings at the request of Trisha Smart (hereafter "Registrant") to grant a third temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896d.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"). Applicant appeared in person pro se. There were no other appearances.

After hearing statements of the Licensing Administrator and Applicant and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of facts, conclusions of law and order:

1) A request for a third temporary registration was filed by Registrant on January 24, 1995.

2) Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 11:30 a.m. on February 11, 1995 was filed herein on January 27, 1995 and mailed to Registrant on that same date.

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3) Registrant has applied for permanent registration as a physician's assistant, but has not passed the NCCPA examination approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-2896(a)(3).

4) Registrant was granted a second temporary registration number, 9401751, which expired on February 15, 1995.

5) Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896d, not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6) Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Registrant should be granted a third temporary registration for a period of year or until the results of the next NCCPA examination become available to the Board, whichever comes first.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

a. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a third temporary registration be granted to Registrant until the Board receives the results from the NCCPA examination to be administered in October, 1995.

b. That in the event Registrant fails to pass the NCCPA examination to be administered in October 1995, the third temporary registration hereby granted to Registrant should expire and be cancelled as of the date of the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board following the date the failure becomes available to the Board.

c. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of

a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
