JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION OF CONSENT ORDER

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record and applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On or about September 1, 2011, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board for alleged violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2901, *et seq.* The Consent Order required Licensee attend and successfully complete a continuing education course entitled “Medical Records Law in Illinois;” attend and successfully complete a continuing education course entitled “Medical Records 101: Responding to Requests for Patient Information;” attend and successfully complete a continuing education course for supervising physician extenders; and attend and successfully complete a continuing education course in the area of practice management, specifically on closing a practice. Licensee was to provide the Board with documentation evidencing completion of the courses by February 12, 2012.

2. On or about April 20, 2012, Licensee submitted documentation evidencing completion of “Medical Records Law” completed on August 30, 2011 in Phoenix, Arizona.

3. On or about September 6, 2012, Board designee, Dr. Michael Beezley, approved modifications to the educational requirements of the Consent Order based on the curriculum submitted with the certificate of successful completion for the "Medical Records Law" course.

4. The modified requirements for the Consent Order discharged Licensee from the requirement to attend and successfully complete a continuing education course in the supervising physician extenders. Further, the completed continuing education course was found to be sufficient to meet the continuing education requirement for a course in the area of practice management, specifically closing a practice.


5. On or about September 6, 2012, Dr. Beezely determined Licensee's submission had fulfilled the modified requirements of Licensee's Consent Order.

6. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and shall have no further obligation for compliance.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee is hereby discharged from all requirements of the Consent Order filed on September 1, 2011.
