FINAL ORDER ON RECONSIDERATION

NOW, on this 10th day of December, 1993, this matter comes on for further consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board") based upon the oral request of reconsideration of the Final Order of Cancellation of License filed November 8, 1993 submitted by Gary L. Snyder, D.P.M. (hereinafter "Licensee"). The Board appears by and through Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator. Licensee does not appear. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the file and hearing the statements of Ms. Abbott and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On August 4, 1993, the Board office received Licensee's License Renewal For Podiatric Medicine form, but such was deemed incomplete as Licensee did not provide proof as required by K.S.A. 65-2005(d) of maintenance of a policy of professional liability insurance as required by K.S.A. 40-3402 and had paid the annual premium surcharge as required by K.S.A. 40-3404.

Administrative notice is taken of all documents in the official agency file in this matter including the Proposed Default Order of Cancellation of License mailed August 11, 1993 and the Final Order of Cancellation of License filed November 8, 1993.

- 2. Subsequent to the filing of the Final Order of Cancellation of License, the Board office was provided with a Certificate of Insurance providing proof that Applicant has had acceptable professional liability insurance coverage from and since August 8, 1993, three days prior to the mailing of the Proposed Default Order of Cancellation of License.
- The Board finds that all previous actions taken as set forth in the Proposed Default Order of Cancellation of License and the Final Order of Cancellation of License were lawful and in compliance with K.S.A. 65-2001, and the et sea. Kansas Administrative Procedure Act. However, based upon additional information received by the Board from and since the issuance of said Order, specifically, verification that Licensee has had professional liability insurance in compliance with Kansas law from and since August 8, 1993 and has paid the appropriate surcharge to the Health Care Stabilization Fund as required by Kansas law, and based upon principles of equity, the Board accepts Licensee's license for renewal for the period of July 1, 1993 through June 30, 1994 to practice podiatric medicine in the State of Kansas.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED as follows:

- a. That the findings here and above made be and the same are hereby made the order of the Board.
- b. That Licensee's license number 12-00223 to practice podiatric medicine in the State of Kansas should be renewed for the period of July 1, 1993 through June 30, 1994.
- c. It is further ordered that the records in the Board office be modified to reflect that Licensee has had a valid license to practice podiatric medicine in the State of Kansas from and since July 1, 1993.
- d. This is a Final Order and is effective upon service on the parties.
