**FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING**

NOW, on this 11<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2005, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the Application for Licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas filed by Ambrosio A. Solano, M.D. ("Applicant"). The Applicant appears in person *pro se*. Kelli Benintendi, Associate Counsel, appears for the Board.

After reviewing the file, hearing the arguments of counsel and the testimony of Applicant, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. On November 12, 2004, Applicant submitted an Application for Licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas which was deemed complete on March 16, 2005.
2. On April 23, 2005, the Board granted Applicant a temporary permit to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas that was to be valid through June 11, 2005.
3. In the Interim Order filed following the conference hearing conducted on April 23, 2005, the Board continued final action on Applicant's Application for Licensure until this date.

5. That Applicant has met the requirements set forth in the Interim Order filed on May 5, 2005, and a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas should be issued to Applicant.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Application for Licensure filed by Applicant should be granted when presented to the Board for final action at its next regular meeting to be held August 13, 2005.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** temporary permit number 0526179 should be extended until August 13, 2005.




