FINAL ORDER

NOW on this 13th day of February, 2015, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the Request for Exception filed by J.S. Spitzer, M.D. (Licensee) in the above-captioned matter. Licensee appears in person and *pro se*. Reese Hays, Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Board.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, specifically K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-529, the Board hereby enters this Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Licensee currently holds an exempt license to practice medicine and surgery as defined in K.S.A. 65-2809(f).
2. K.S.A. 65-2809(f), allows an exempt license holder to serve as a coroner or a paid employee of a local health department or an indigent health care clinic.
3. Licensee has been approached to be employed by Horizons Mental Health Center in Hutchinson, Kansas. Horizons Mental Health Center is neither a local health department nor an indigent health care clinic as defined by K.S.A. 65-241 or K.S.A. 75-6201 and amendments thereto.

4. Licensee submitted Exhibit A to the Board which contains eight (8) paragraphs describing Licensee's duties as the primary care consultant for Horizons Mental Health Clinic.
5. The Board concludes that paragraphs 1, 4, 7, and 8 of Licensee's Exhibit A would constitute the active practice of medicine if performed by Licensee with an exempt license, and are therefore prohibited by K.S.A. 65-2809(f).
6. The Board further concludes that paragraphs 2, 3, 5, and 6 would be permitted activities under Licensee's exempt licensure.
