12. Pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (“KAPA”), K.S.A. 77-536, the Board is authorized to suspend a licensee’s license when it is determined there is an imminent threat to the public health, safety and welfare.

13. The Board concludes that Licensee’s license should be suspended until such time that he can practice with reasonable skill and safety. Licensee may appear before the Board at its regularly scheduled meeting in February in order to demonstrate


that he is able to again practice with reasonable skill and safety.

**IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED** that Licensee's license is hereby immediately suspended until such time that Licensee demonstrates his ability to practice with reasonable skill and safety.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that this an emergency order on the motion for emergency order of suspension and a final order on the petition. An emergency order is effective when rendered. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's Executive Director at 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603-3068.


