
JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION

1. On or about July 11, 2016, Edward S. Stanton, M.D. (“Licensee”) entered into a Consent Order with the Board for alleged violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.* Such Consent Order was ratified by the Board on or about October 14, 2016. The Consent Order required that Licensee enter into, complete and pass all five (5) topic areas of the EBAS Essay Examination that is provided by Ethics and Boundaries Assessment Services, LLC.
2. On July 27, 2016, Licensee submitted to the Board documentation evidencing his successful completion and passing of the aforementioned examination.
3. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and has no further obligation for compliance.
