ORDER MODIFYING LICENSE STATUS

NOW on this 11th day of August, 1990, comes on for determination by the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, (hereafter "Board") the status of license number 4-22082 held by Curtis C. Stautz, M.D. (hereafter "Licensee"). Board members present on August 11, 1990 are: Franklin Bichlmeier, M.D., President; Donald B. Bletz, M.D.; Cameron D. Knackstedt, D.O.; Mark J. Hatesohl, D.C.; John P. White, D.O.; P. Tom Greene, D.C.; Glenn J. Kerbs; Irwin Waxman, DPM; Jimmy Buller, D.O.; Joseph Philipp, M.D.; Graciela Marion; Kenneth Wedel, M.D.; and Ronald J. Zoeller, D.C. The Board's General Counsel, Lawrence T. Buening, Jr. appeared in person. There are no other appearances.

After hearing the arguments of the Board's General Counsel and reviewing the documentation provided by Licensee and the Kansas Insurance Department and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following determinations:

1. Prior to April 5, 1990, Licensee mailed notification to the Board office requesting a temporary change of licensure status from inactive to active. Said notification was mailed to the

Board's previous office address and evidently not forwarded to the current Board location.

2. Licensee entered Kansas and practiced as an locum tenens from April 5, 1990 to April 14, 1990.

3. Licensee was unaware that he had practiced medicine and surgery in Kansas without holding an active Kansas license until he was so informed by the Kansas Insurance Department. Upon receipt of such notification by the Kansas Insurance Department, Licensee contacted the Board office requesting assistance in remedying the situation.

4. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2803, the Board, as the sole and exclusive authority to issue licenses to practice the healing arts in the State of Kansas, has jurisdiction in this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:


A. Licensee's request for a retroactive change in his license status from inactive to active for the period April 5 to April 15, 1990 should be granted for the reason that Licensee had taken the appropriate steps in notifying the Board office of his intentions to practice as an locum tenens during this time period.

B. This Order is a Final Order and will become effective upon execution.


IT IS SO ORDERED.


