COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record and applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

- 1. On or about August 20, 2015, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board for alleged violations of the Kansas Athletic Trainers Licensure Act, K.S.A. 65-6901, et seq. The Consent Order required Licensee to submit to the Board an essay regarding a discussion of regulating the profession of athletic training through licensure; a discussion regarding the importance of knowing what a profession's scope of practice; and a discussion regarding the consequences of practicing without a license.
 - 2. On or about August 28, 2015, Licensee submitted the required essay.
- 3. The Board-appointed member of Disciplinary Panel #29 determined that the essay submission fulfilled the essay requirement of Licensee's Consent Order.
- 4. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and has no further obligation for compliance.
