JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION


COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record and applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On or about August 20, 2015, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board for alleged violations of the Kansas Athletic Trainers Licensure Act, K.S.A. 65-6901, *et seq.* The Consent Order required Licensee to submit to the Board an essay regarding a discussion of regulating the profession of athletic training through licensure; a discussion regarding the importance of knowing what a profession’s scope of practice; and a discussion regarding the consequences of practicing without a license.
2. On or about August 28, 2015, Licensee submitted the required essay.
3. The Board-appointed member of Disciplinary Panel #29 determined that the essay submission fulfilled the essay requirement of Licensee’s Consent Order.
4. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and has no further obligation for compliance.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee is hereby discharged from all requirements of the Consent Order filed on June 1, 2015.
