FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 16th day of April, 1994, comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") sitting as a whole as a Presiding Officer in a conference proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535 the request of G. Gayle Stephens, M.D. ("Licensee") for retroactive modification of license status. The Board appears by and through Gretchen E. Schmidt, Associate Counsel. Licensee does not appear.

After reviewing the request, hearing statements of counsel and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the following findings and orders are made:

1. Licensee was originally issued license number 4-10377 to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas on December 15, 1952.

2. The license of Licensee was cancelled at the request of Licensee on June 1, 1987.

3. On December 15, 1992, the Board received Licensee's application for reinstatement, which application was determined to be complete and Licensee's license was reinstated on June 11, 1993.

4. Licensee practiced medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas for the period of December 12-19, 1992 without first having had his license reinstated by the Board.

5. On July 13, 1993, Licensee requested that he have his license reinstated for the period of December 12-19, 1992.

6. That it was due to Licensee's misunderstanding and mistake that he practiced medicine and surgery during the period of December 12-19, 1992 without first having his license reinstated.

IT IS THEREFORE by the Board ordered as follows:

a) That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the order of the Board.

b) That the license of Licensee to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas should be reinstated for the period of December 12-19, 1992 on the condition that an administrative fine in the amount of three hundred dollars (\$300) be assessed to Licensee for his violation of the Healing Arts Act in practicing medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas without the benefit of current licensure during the aforementioned period.

c) The administrative fine is to be received in the Board office within thirty (30) days of service of this order and if not so received, this order shall be null and void and no retroactive modification to the licensure status of Licensee shall be made or become effective. Provided, however, that should said

fine be received in the Board office within 30 days of service of this order, the Board records be modified to reflect that Licensee had an active license in the State of Kansas for the period of December 12-19, 1992.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
