STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 2<sup>d</sup> day of AUGUST, 1985 by and between the KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS (hereinafter referred to as "Board") and DAVID R. STONE, M.D. (hereinafter referred to as "Licensee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of April, 1985 the Board declared the Stipulation previously entered into between the parties dated null and void and directed its Disciplinary Counsel to institute formal charges against Licensee; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of the prosecution of formal charges, the parties mutually desire to enter into a further Stipulation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the forbearance of a formal hearing and the other covenants and promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Licensee hereby surrenders his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, said license being number 19432 and Licensee further relinquishes all of the rights and privileges accorded him by said license.

2. Subject to the conditions set forth in paragraph 3, Licensee may apply for reinstatement of his license at any time by complying with the applicable statutes and rules and regulations of the Board then in effect.

3. Licensee shall not apply for reinstatement of his license unless and until he can provide satisfactory evidence of all of the following:

4. Upon Licensee's submission of an application for reinstatement and the evidence required by paragraph 3, the Board will give due consideration to the application and will not deny reinstatement without cause.

5. Should the Board approve the reinstatement of Licensee's license, it shall have the right to place such restrictions, limitations and requirements thereon as shall be deemed appropriate, including but not limited to a requirement that the Licensee appear before the Board at periodic intervals.

6. In the event Licensee has not fully complied with the continuing educational requirements of the Board at the time action is taken on any application for reinstatement, reinstatement will not be denied as a result of such noncompliance.

8. This constitutes the entire agreement of the parties. Any representation or agreement not specifically stated herein is null and void and of no force and effect.

9. Licensee has entered into this Stipulation freely and voluntarily and without any coercion or duress on the part of the Board.

10. This Stipulation shall remain in full force and effect until rescinded or modified by action of the Board.
