ORDER OF RESCISSION

NOW, on this 15th day of August, 1989, comes on for determination by Summary Adjudicative Proceedings before THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS (here and after referred to as "Board") serving as Presiding Officer, and upon its own motion pursuant to K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 77-539 for administrative review of the Order of Emergency Suspension of license dated November 10, 1988 and filed in the entitled matter.

After reviewing the file and hearing the statements and arguments of Joseph M. Furjanic, Disciplinary Counsel, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises the Board finds as follows:

(1). That on the tenth day of November, 1988, the Board issued, by and through its Executive Director, an Order of Emergency Suspension of license of the license of Robert J. Strange, M.D.

(2). That in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 65-2809, the Board notified Licensee of the expiration of his license and provided to him the form required to be submitted to the Board in order to renew said license.

(3). That Licensee failed to renew said license on or before July 30, 1989 and, in accordance with K.S.A. Supp. 65-2809 (d), Licensee's license was canceled on August 1, 1989 due to non-renewal.

(4) That the effect of the cancellation of Licensee's license due to non-renewal is that Licensee no longer has a valid license to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.


(5) As a result of the cancellation of Licensee's license and the resultant loss of Licensee's ability to actively engage

in practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, the imminent danger to the Public Health, Safety and Welfare which existed at the time of the issuance of the Order of Emergency Suspension of license has now been alleviated.

(6). That since Licensee may no longer practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas as the result of the cancellation of his license to do so, the Order of Emergency Suspension of license should be rescinded.

(7). It IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD CONSIDERED, ORDERED, JUDGED AND DECREED that the Order of Emergency Suspension of License issued November 10, 1988, should be immediately rescinded without prejudice and that Robert J. Strange, M.D. is entitled to an Administrative Review of this Order of Rescission if a written request is received in the Board office within fifteen (15) days of service of this Order upon said Licensee.

ORDER OF EMERGENCY SUSPENSION OF LICENSE

NOW, on this 10th day of November, 1988, the above entitled matter comes before the Board pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2338 and K.S.A. 77-536.

After reviewing the investigative file and being duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter referred to as "Board") by and through its Executive Director, Richard G. Gannon, finds as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That, ROBERT J. STRANGE, M.D. (hereinafter referred to as "Licensee") is currently licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas and holds certificate number 22293, originally issued on June 17, 1988.

2. That, information was brought to the attention of the Disciplinary Counsel of the Board and the Executive Director of the Board that indicated Licensee may be unable to practice medicine and surgery with reasonable skill and safety to patients.

3. That, these matters were thoroughly investigated and reviewed by Joseph M. Furjanic, Disciplinary Counsel and Richard G. Gannon, Executive Director of the Board, acting for the Board.

4. That, the Board found there was reasonable cause to believe that Licensee had violated the Kansas Healing Arts Act in the following respects:

5. That, the licensee has the inability to practice the branch of the healing arts for which licensee is licensed with reasonable skill and safety to patients (confidential)

6. That, the aforementioned findings constitute reasonable cause to believe that the actions and conduct of the Licensee violated K.S.A. 1987 Supp. 65-2836 to 64-2844, inclusive, and

amendments thereto and thereby may result in the revocation, suspension, or limitation of license of licensee.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND POLICY REASONS

7. That, there is cause to believe that grounds exist under K.S.A. 1987 Supp. 65-2836 and 65-2844 inclusive and amendments thereto for the revocation, suspension, or limitation of the license of Licensee.

8. That, due to the alleged violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act by Licensee there is an immediate and imminent danger to the public health, safety, or welfare which can only be prevented or avoided by the immediate suspension of Licensee's license.

9. That, the necessary action which must be taken by the Board to prevent or avoid the immediate danger to the public health, safety and welfare is to suspend the license of Licensee and thereby prohibit Licensee from practicing medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas while he remains in violation of the Kansas Health Arts Act as above stated.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS BY THE BOARD CONSIDERED ORDERED:

10. That, the findings, conclusions of law and policy reasons hereinabove made and set forth be and the same are hereby made the order of the Board.

11. That, the license of the Licensee is hereby suspended.


