NOW, on this 26th day of February, 2007, the above-entitled matter comes on before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts. After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Executive Director makes the following determinations:

1. On December 2, 2006, the Board approved a Consent Order affecting the license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas for Charles E. Stuckey, M.D. ("Licensee").


2. The Consent Order censured Licensee for violation of the healing arts act; assessed a civil fine in the amount of \$5,000, and required the Licensee to successfully complete the ProBE Professional/Problem Based Ethics course on or before April 30, 2007. The Consent Order was filed and mailed on December 5, 2006.

3. Pursuant to the Consent Order, check #1285 in the amount of \$5,000 was received on December 5, 2006. On February 23, 2007 the Board received verification from The Ethics Group, LLC dated February 16, 2007, that Licensee had successfully completed the ProBE Professional/Problem Based Ethics course.

4. Licensee has fully complied with all requirements set forth in the Consent Order and has no further obligation under said Order.


