**FINAL ORDER TERMINATING MONITORING**

NOW on this 12th day of June, 2015, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Bradley K. Stucky, D.O. (“Licensee”) for termination of the monitoring requirement contained in the Consent Order filed on June 30, 2014. Licensee appears in person and *pro se*. Jane Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving evidence, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. On April 17, 2015, Licensee submitted a request to the Board for termination of the monitoring provisions contained in his Consent Order.
2. On May 13, 2015, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Petition for Termination of Monitoring and included documentary evidence of Licensee’s compliance with his monitoring requirement.

3. Based upon the documentary evidence submitted and arguments at the hearing, the Board finds that Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and concludes that termination of the monitoring requirement is warranted in the circumstances.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS** that the monitoring requirements imposed by the Consent Order filed on June 30, 2014, are hereby **TERMINATED** and that Licensee shall have no further obligation for compliance.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529, Licensee may petition the Board for Reconsideration of a Final Order within fifteen (15) days following service of the final order. Additionally, a party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court, as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within **30 days** following service of the Final Order. 
