ORDER GRANTING SECOND TEMPORARY REGISTRATION

NOW, on this 12th day of March, 1994, this matter comes on for conference proceedings at the request of David Patrick Sulzman, (hereafter "Registrant") to grant a second temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896d.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, appears on behalf of the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"). Registrant appears in person pro se. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the files, hearing statements of Registrant and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of facts, conclusions of law and order:

1) A request for a second temporary registration was filed by Registrant on February 21, 1994.

2) Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 8:30 a.m. on March 12, 1994 was filed herein on February 25, 1994 and served on Registrant on that same date.

3) Registrant has applied for permanent registration as a physician's assistant, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-2896a(a)(3).

4) On September 14, 1993 Registrant was granted a temporary registration number, 9400394, which expired on February 15, 1994.

5) Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896d, not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6) Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Registrant should be granted a second temporary registration until results from the NCCPA examination to be administered in October 1994 become available.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

a. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a second temporary registration be granted to Registrant until the Board receives the results from the NCCPA examination to be administered in October, 1994.

b. That in the event Registrant fails to pass the NCCPA examination to be administered in October 1994, the second temporary registration hereby granted to Registrant should expire and be cancelled as of the date of the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board following the date the failure becomes available to the Board.

c. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
