JOURNAL ENTRY OF DISMISSAL

NOW, on this 23<sup>d</sup> day of March, 1995, this matter comes before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") on the Motion to Dismiss filed by Ronald Dean Summers, M.D. (hereafter "Respondent") on June 6, 1994. There are no appearances.

After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Executive Director of the Board orders and finds as follows:

1. On June 25, 1992 a Petition was filed in the above-entitled matter alleging that Respondent had failed to comply with the Stipulation and Enforcement Order filed in the Board office on April 13, 1992.

2. On June 30, 1992, the license issued to Respondent expired for Respondent's failure to renew and thereafter was cancelled on August 17, 1992.

3. On December 2, 1992, an Initial Order was filed in this matter and thereafter Respondent filed a Petition For Review Of Initial Order on December 14, 1992.

4. On February 13, 1993, the Board as a whole heard arguments and received briefs on Respondent's Petition for Review

be remanded back to the Presiding Officer pursuant to K.S.A. 77-528.

5. On August 9, 1993, an Order Of Remand was entered by the Board implementing the Board's decision of February 13, 1993, which remanded the matter back to the Presiding Officer and requested that additional hearing be held on the issues raised by the Respondent in his Petition for Review of Initial Order filed December 14, 1992 and orally argued before the Board on February 13, 1993.

6. Information received by the Executive Director reflects that on or about September 22, 1993, the Presiding Officer was contacted by the Disciplinary Counsel for the Board and advised that the parties were attempting to reach a Consent Agreement; further correspondence reviewed by the Executive Director reflects that attempts to resolve the matter were initiated between the Respondent and the Board's Disciplinary Counsel, but never finalized.

7. In the Motion To Dismiss, filed June 6, 1994, it was alleged by Respondent that he has not practiced in Kansas since the cancellation of his license on August 17, 1992 and does not intend to return to the practice of medicine and surgery in this State or to apply for reinstatement of his license to so practice.

8. This matter is appropriate for dismissal based upon the aforementioned facts.
