**FINAL ORDER**

**NOW ON THIS** Eighteenth Day of October 2003, comes before the Board a motion to terminate the limitations imposed by a stipulation and agreement and enforcement order entered into on April 12, 1999. Dr. Swanson appears in person and through Richard E. McLeod, Attorney at Law. Stacy L. Cook appears for the Board.

This is Dr. Swanson's second motion to terminate the limitations. The first request was denied in a Final Order dated March 8, 2002. The Board found at that time that it had insufficient information to determine whether the monitoring of Dr. Swanson professional practice should be terminated.

The Board finds that Dr. Swanson's practice had been continuously monitored since April 12, 1999, and that he has submitted a sufficient number of patient charts to determine whether he practices within the standard of care.

For good cause shown, the Board terminates the limitations imposed by the April 12, 1999 order.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-610, et seq. Reconsideration of the

Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's executive director at 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.
