**FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT**

NOW on this 17<sup>th</sup> day of August 2012, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the application of Nicholas M. Szary, M.D. (“Applicant”) for licensure by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears in person and *pro se*. Reese Hays, Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the file, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. On or about July 5, 2012, Applicant submitted an application for licensure by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Such application was deemed complete and filed with the Board on or about August 7, 2012.
2. In May of 2004, Applicant graduated from Saba University School of Medicine in the Dutch Carribean.
3. At the time of Applicant’s matriculation in 2000, Saba University School of Medicine was neither approved nor specifically disapproved by the Board.

4. In 2002, the Board approved Saba and added it to the list of approved medical schools.

5. Applicant passed all 3 steps of the USMLE within 10 years as required by K.S.A. 65-2873.

6. Applicant completed three (3) years of Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited residency in internal medicine and a one (1) year gastroenterology fellowship at the University of Missouri in Columbia. Applicant also completed a one (1) year fellowship in Interventional Endoscopy at Georgetown University Hospital in Washington, D.C.

7. Applicant is currently board certified in Internal Medicine and board eligible in Gastroenterology.


8. Applicant is currently licensed in both the State of Missouri and the District of Columbia, and has been since May of 2012 in both states. Applicant also held a resident license in Missouri from 2004 to 2011.

9. Applicant received his Education Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) certification in May 2004.

10. The Board finds that based on Applicant's individual qualifications and educational experience, he has demonstrated satisfactory fulfillment of K.S.A. 65-2833 to be granted a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS** that Applicant is hereby granted a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.


