FINAL ORDER TERMINATING CONSENT ORDER

NOW on this 11th day of October 2019, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Mary C. Takaishi, P.A. (“Licensee”) for termination of the Consent Order filed on December 22, 2014. Licensee appears in person and with counsel Megan Moseley. Nancy Dodik, Associate Disciplinary Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-28a01 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving evidence, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. On August 27, 2019, Licensee submitted a request to the Board for termination of the Consent Order.
2. On September 11, 2019, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Petition for Termination of Consent Order.
3. The Board finds that the Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and concludes that termination of the Consent Order is warranted under the circumstances.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that the Consent Order filed on December 22, 2014 is **TERMINATED** and that the Licensee shall have no further obligation for compliance.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529, Licensee may petition the Board for Reconsideration of a Final Order within fifteen (15) days following service of the final order. Additionally, a party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court, as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within **30 days** following service of the Final Order. 
