**ORDER SETTING ASIDE ISSUANCE OF
INSTITUTIONAL LICENSE**

NOW, on this 11th day of December, 1992, comes on before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole in Summary Proceedings for further consideration and review of the request of Said N. Tawfeek, M.D. (hereafter "Licensee") to set aside the issuance of institutional license number 8-00242 granted September 8, 1992 to expire September 8, 1994.

After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On September 8, 1992 Licensee filed with the Board office a fully completed Application for Institutional License to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas. As part of that application, it was indicated Licensee had been employed by Larned State Hospital.

2. Upon receipt, Licensee's application was deemed complete and assigned institutional license number 08-00242 effective September 8, 1992 through September 8, 1994.

3. Licensee apparently had entered into a written contract with the Kansas Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services, specifically Larned State Hospital for services as a medical doctor in that facility.

4. On October 28, 1992, the Board office received notification from Larned State Hospital that the employment of Licensee had not materialized at that facility and there was no plan to employ him. It was indicated that Licensee desired to have the institutional license issued to him cancelled.

5. Following receipt of the correspondence from Larned State Hospital, Board staff subsequently contacted Licensee by letter dated October 30, 1992 and informed him of the request made by Larned State Hospital and provided certain options regarding the status of the institutional license and requested Licensee respond to the Board office with his intentions and/or desires.

6. On November 25, 1992, Board staff again through written correspondence with Licensee informed him of the request made by SRS to cancel institutional license number 08-00242 and requested a response.

7. On November 29, 1992, Board staff received a written correspondence from Licensee indicating his desire to cancel and/or nullify institutional license number 08-00242 as if it had never been issued.

8. Licensee has never performed services as an employee of either the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services or

the Department of Corrections so as to make the institutional license issued to him valid and has not performed any other professional services in the state of Kansas under said license.

9. Based upon the above facts, it is the finding of the Board and deemed to be in the best interest of justice and fairness that institutional license number 08-00242 issued to Licensee September 8, 1992 be set aside and be considered null and void ab initio as if it had never been issued.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

A. That institutional license number 08-00242 issued September 8, 1992 in the above entitled case be set aside and declared null and void ab initio as if it had never been issued.

B. That should Licensee obtain qualified employment required for an institutional license that he will be entitled to apply for a new institutional license which, if issued, would have an entitled period of validity of two full years.

C. Licensee is entitled to an administrative review of this Order Setting Aside Issuance of Institutional License if a written request is received in the Board office within fifteen (15) days of the date of service of this Order upon Licensee.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


