



NOW, on this 6th day of March, 2008, the above-entitled matter comes on before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (“Board”). After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Executive Director makes the following determinations:

1. On February 14, 2008, the Executive Director, on behalf of the Board, issued a Revised Summary Order in which it was determined that Michael B. Tentori, D.O. should be assessed a fine in the amount of \$500.00, payable within 30 days of the effective date of the order, for failure to have met the continuing education requirements at the time he renewed his license and should provide documentation of completion of at least 42 continuing education credits in Category I or Category II before June 2, 2008.

2. The Revised Summary Order was filed and mailed on February 14, 2008, and contained a notice that it would become effective within 15 following service if no request for hearing was received prior to the effective date of the Revised Summary Order.

2. No hearing has been requested by any party and, therefore, the Summary Order became effective on March 6, 2008; the fine in the amount of \$500 is due and payable on or before April 4, 2008; and, as stated in the Revised Summary Order,

documentation of completion of at least 42 continuing education credits in Category I or Category II shall be provided on or before June 2, 2008.



REVISED SUMMARY ORDER

NOW, on this 14th day of February, 2008, the above-entitled matter comes on for further Summary Proceedings before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537. After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Executive Director makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders for and on behalf of the Board:

1. On January 28, 2008, a Summary Order of Cancellation of License was filed in the Board office cancelling the license of Michael B Tentori, M.D. (“Licensee”) to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas effective February 18, 2008, for failure to provide documentation that he had completed the continuing education requirements for renewal.

2. As stated in the Summary Order of Cancellation of License, Licensee had previously not provided any documentation that he had completed the continuing education requirements for renewal of his license for the period October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2008.

3. K.A.R. 100-15-5 requires each licensee who renews a license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery to have completed a minimum of 50 contact hours of continuing education April 1, 2006, with a minimum of 20 hours in Category I and a

maximum of 30 hours in Category II, 100 hours contact of contact hours since April 1, 2005, with at least 40 hours in Category II, or 150 hours of continuing education since April 1, 2004, with a at least 60 hours of Category I.

4. On February 14, 2008, Licensee provided documentation that he had obtained 29 hours contact hours of Category I continuing education from April 1, 2006 and no hours of Category II continuing education from April 1, 2006.

5. Based on Policy Statement No. 05-04, a Licensee who has deficient continuing education hours shall complete twice the number of deficient continuing education hours within 90 days and be fined the sum of \$500.

6. Based on the information provided by Licensee, Licensee was deficient in 21 hours of Category I and/or Category II hours when he renewed his license.

7. Based on the Policy Statement, Licensee must complete 42 Category I or Category II hours within 90 days of the effective date of this Summary Order.

8. Based on Policy Statement No. 05-04, Licensee should be assessed a civil fine in the amount of \$500, payable within 30 days of the effective date of this order for his failure to have had the required continuing education at the time she renewed her license.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED the Summary Order of Cancellation of License filed January 28, 2008, is set aside and shall not become effective.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Licensee is assessed a civil fine in the amount of \$500, payable within 30 days of the effective date of this order, for failure to have met the continuing education requirements at the time he renewed her license.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Licensee shall provide documentation of completion of at least 42 continuing education credits in Category I or Category II before June 2, 2008.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a summary order. A party to whom a summary order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following service of the summary order. If a hearing is not requested, the summary order shall become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing. 

SUMMARY ORDER OF CANCELLATION OF LICENSE

NOW, on this *28th* day of January 2008, this matter comes before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537.

After reviewing the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders are made for and on behalf of the Board:

1. License number 05-27929 issued to Michael B Tentori ("Licensee") to practice as an Osteopathic Doctor in the state of Kansas expired on September 30, 2007, pursuant to K.A.R. 100-15-1.

2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2809, as amended, a license not renewed within 30 days following the date of expiration shall be deemed cancelled by operation of law.

3. K.A.R.100-15-5 requires each Licensee desiring to renew a Osteopathic Doctor license to submit to the Board documented evidence of completion of a minimum of 50 contact hours of continuing education since April 1, 2006, or 100 contact hours of continuing education since April 1, 2005, or 150 contact hours of continuing education since April 1, 2004 before or with the request for renewal.

4. K.S.A. 40-3402 requires each Licensee desiring to renew an Osteopathic Doctor license to maintain a policy of professional liability insurance and K.S.A. 40-3404 requires payment of the premium surcharges.

5. On or about September 1, 2007, Licensee submitted an application for renewal of their license.

6. As part of the renewal process, Licensee certified that the rules regarding proof of continuing education had been read, that the required number of continuing education hours had been achieved, and that documentation of those hours would be maintained for a three-year period and produced to the Board upon request.

7. As part of the renewal process, Licensee certified that the rules regarding professional liability insurance had been read, that compliance had been achieved, and that documentation of the professional liability insurance policy would be maintained for a three-year period and produced to the Board upon request.

8. As part of the renewal process, Licensee further certified that the notice regarding the Board's procedures for auditing continuing education compliance and professional liability insurance compliance had been read.

9. Licensee was randomly selected to provide verification of compliance with the continuing education requirements and on December 1, 2007, was mailed a letter requesting that Licensee provide, no later than January 2, 2008, the records relied upon when Licensee certified achievement of the required continuing education hours and insurance.

10. On January 7, 2008, the required documents had not been received and a second notice was mailed requesting that the Licensee provide, no later than January 25, 2008, the

records relied upon when Licensee certified achievement of the required continuing education hours and professional liability insurance.

11. Licensee has failed to provide documented evidence of completion of a minimum of 50 contact hours of continuing education from and since April 1, 2006, or 100 contact hours of continuing education since April 1, 2005, or 150 contact hours of continuing education since April 1, 2004 and proof of professional liability insurance.

12. By failing to provide documented evidence of completion of the required continuing education and professional liability insurance, Licensee has not met the requirements for license renewal for the period October 1, 2007, through September 30, 2008; therefore, the license issued to Licensee should be cancelled effective February 18, 2008.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the license of Licensee issued by the Board to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas is cancelled effective February 18, 2008, due to failure to renew as provided by K.S.A. 65-2809.


