ORDER RESCINDING STIPULATION

NOW, on this 12th day of April, 1986, comes on for hearing the request of George R. Tiller, M.D. (hereafter "Licensee") for modification of Stipulation. The Licensee appears in person.

After reviewing the file, hearing the statements of Licensee and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") finds as follows:

1. That on or about February 13, 1984, the Board and Licensee entered into a Stipulation which required Licensee to fulfill certain conditions and requirements, a copy of which is attached hereto and marked Exhibit A.

2. That it appears Licensee has fully complied with all of the requirements placed upon him as set forth in Exhibit A from and since the date of its execution.

3. That the Stipulation between the parties as set forth in Exhibit A should be rescinded in its entirety and hereafter declared null and void.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE BOARD sitting in regular session that the Stipulation between Licensee and Board as set forth in Exhibit A be rescinded in its entirety and shall hereafter be null and void and of no further force and effect.
