FINAL ORDER
(Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-501 et seq.)

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) by K.S.A. 65-2801 et seq. and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 et seq., the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. Members of the Board serving on the Disciplinary Panel for this matter were recused from participation.

I. Findings of Fact

The Board has been shown the following facts:

1. Andrea Rae Tjaden (“Licensee”), 3901 Rainbow Blvd., Radiology Department, Kansas City, KS 66160, is licensed to practice radiologic technology in the State of Kansas, License No. 22-03571, and has been so licensed since October 16, 2009.
2. On or about October 19, 2009, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board as a condition to being granted licensure as a radiologic technologist.

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5. On or about August 30, 2010, the Board filed a Petition alleging that Licensee violated the Consent Order, and thereby, the Radiologic Technologists Practice Act.

6. On or about December 16, 2010, the Board continued the matter, by agreement of the parties, until the February 25, 2011 Board Meeting to enable

II. Conclusions of Law

Based upon the Findings of Fact enumerated in Paragraphs #1 through #7, the Applicable Law set forth above:

THE BOARD HEREBY CONCLUDES AS FOLLOWS:

- 8. On or about October 19, 2009, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board as a condition to being granted licensure as a radiologic technologist.

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11. On or about August 30, 2010, the Board filed a Petition alleging that Licensee violated the Consent Order, and thereby, the Radiologic Technologists Practice Act.

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14. The Board finds continued monitoring is required based upon the facts of this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS:

15. The terms and conditions of the Consent Order dated October 19, 2009 are extended for a period of at least one (1) additional year from the time of the original Consent Order.

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
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21. Licensee shall pay costs to the Board in the amount of \$250.00. Such costs is payable in full to the "Kansas Board of Healing Arts" on or before May 1, 2011.

22. The Board shall maintain jurisdiction over this matter to issue any Order(s) deemed necessary and appropriate.
