

STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 8th day of April, 1985, by and between the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, hereinafter referred to as "Board" and Roger Chernot Troup, M.D., hereinafter referred to as "Licensee".

WITNESSES:

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of July 1982, Licensee entered into a Stipulation and Order with the Colorado State Board of Medical Examiners in which Licensee's license was limited by him being placed on a period of probation and Licensee was required to perform and/or comply with various other conditions; and

WHEREAS, the limitation of Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Colorado constitutes an act for which the Board may revoke, suspend or limit the license of Licensee; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of proceeding with formal proceedings, the parties mutually desire to enter into this stipulation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the forbearance of additional investigation, review committee hearing and formal disciplinary proceedings and the other covenants and promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Licensee shall comply in all respects with the Stipulation and Order entered into between himself and the Colorado State Board of Medical Examiners on July 7, 1982.
2. Licensee consents and authorizes the Colorado State Board of Medical Examiners to release to the Board any and all information relating to the Licensee's compliance with the aforementioned Stipulation and Order and/or any violations thereof.
3. It is further understood and agreed that the provisions of the aforementioned Stipulation and Order and this Stipulation are to be strictly construed and adhered to. In the event Licensee fails to comply with all of the terms and conditions

of the aforementioned Stipulation and Order or any of the provisions contained herein, this Stipulation, at the option of the Board shall become null and void and the Board shall have the right to require Disciplinary Counsel to file formal charges against Licensee.

4. This Stipulation constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and there are no other agreements or understandings regarding any matter in question herein other than that expressly set forth herein.

5. This Stipulation shall remain in full force and effect for as long as licensee remains on the probation imposed by the Colorado State Board of Medical Examiners. If Licensee successfully adheres to the terms of the aforementioned Stipulation and Order and the disciplinary proceedings in Colorado are thereby closed and concluded in all respects, this Stipulation shall become null and void and of no further force and effect on the date the Board receives satisfactory notification of such from the Colorado State Board of Medical Examiners.
